WHAT DOES METLIFE INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT, LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and employment information
- Assets and income
- Credit Card or Other Debt and account balances

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons MetLife Investment Management, LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does MetLife Investment Management, LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. In addition, to the extent we outsource support services to unaffiliated third parties, we require these third parties to protect personal information.	
How does MetLife Investment Management, LLC collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you purchase a limited partnership interest in a private investment fund managed by us and/or sign a subscription agreement.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	If you hold an account jointly with someone else, we will accept instructions from either of you, and apply them to the entire account.
